1. Present

No apologies were received.

2. Declarations of interest

None were received.

3. Opportunity for public to speak by Zoom or in person.

No requests were received.

4. Minutes of the last meeting

The minutes of the last meeting were read by the Chair, proposed as correct by Jenny Alty and seconded by Nicky Whitting.

5. Matters arising

- a) Ffridd and Pentre Du footpath - Clerk to speak to Robert W. Jones for an update on Ffridd footpath and path from Pentre Du down to the shore. The neighbouring field currently floods affecting the path. People have been putting stones and bricks on the path which doesn't help matters. The hedge near the path also needs attention.

The stones and gravel at the bottom of the Ffridd will be removed when work is done on the footpath.

- b) The Clerk has spoken to Andrew GRegson, Gwynedd Council Highways Officer, to again highlight parking problems in light of the huge volume of traffic in the village.

The Clerk has also highlighted the danger of emergency vehicles not being able to attend if a problem arises. The fact that there has been an increase in footfall (plus dogs) walking through the village was also discussed.

Helen Flook suggested requesting a vehicle counter to monitor the number of cars that visit the village / Aber Falls. The Clerk to send an email to the appropriate department at Gwynedd Council.

- c) It was noted that the bus shelter is in need of attention once more following vandalism. The Clerk to check what needs doing regarding repair work and will discuss with councillors to arrange the required work.

The Finance Report was read by the Clerk. The balance appears healthy.

8. Training

Jenny Alty would like to do some further training in August via Zoom. All councillors were supportive. Jenny Alty to book the training via One Voice Wales and the Clerk will arrange the required payments.
