Thursday 18<sup>th</sup> September 2025, 7:30 p.m. Yr Hen Felin.

1. Present Jenny Alty (Chair), Helen Flook (Vice Chair), Nicky Whitting, Ann Pennell, Eryl Williams.
2. Declaration of Interest None.
3. Opportunity for public to speak in person or by Zoom None.
4. Jenny Alty (Chair ) read the minutes of AGM and general meeting held on 26 June. Proposed as correct by N Whitting and seconded by A Pennell.
5. Matters arising
  - a) Roland Flook Informed us, no charge for painting the Bus Shelter.
  - b) Clark in regular contact with Team Tacluso re Cycle Path rubbish between the village and Tan Lon.
  - c) Cycle track by Pen y Bryn Hill — leave further enquiries for now until decision made on temporary car park at Pen y Bryn .
  - d) The hedges have been cut along the road from village to Cremlyn and from Bontnewydd car park to Mountain Gate .
  - e) Village clean up to be arranged for 19th OCTOBER ,meet 10am @Hen Felin .RR to organize Poster and a message will be sent on Mailchimp .

7. Financial report read by Clerk, See copy. Agreed as correct by Jenny Alty, seconded by Helen Flook.
8. Audit return 2024-2025 not returned yet ,clerk has not received any queries from Audit Wales up to now.The audit should be returned from Cardiff by 30th September .A notice of conclusion of Audit to be placed in village noticeboard for at least 14 days along with the certified Annual Returns.
9. Training Jenny Alty to attend Data Protection Course when a suitable date available before end of year .
10. AOB
  - a) Traffic .Andrew Gregson ,Cyngor Gwynedd met with NWhitting(Chair ) , and Hywel Thomas (Chair ) ARC an RR (Clark )on 9th July to discuss double yellow lines outside Capel Soar, repainting double yellow lines around and in front of

Bus Stop, Extending the double yellow lines from behind Caffi Alma past opposite Ceris to the junction, and double yellow lines by Aber Falls Hotel in order to enable Buses to manoeuvre easily. The requests have been sent to Cyngor Gwynedd but AG did explain that there could be a delay due to only one firm from Liverpool to carry out the work.

A second traffic meeting was held with AG, NW, HF, and HT (ARC), on 20th August to discuss cars parking under the underpass, and opposite the underpass on both sides of the road into the village making it very difficult for Buses to pass stationary vehicles.

A Gregson again explained that there is a further delay in having lines painted due to the delay with painting around the Bus Stop. It was suggested a "No entry, BUSES ONLY" sign is needed.

It was suggested by HT that a Clearway order should be put in place between Tan y Graig and Bontnewydd. Also a "NO ENTRY to the FALLS" sign be requested and placed at the bottom of Mountain gate road.

The Cul de Sac sign now in place on post by Bodfan Almshouse.

- b) Dylan's Temporary Car park email discussed, Jenny Alty (chair) to draft a letter to respond to request and circulate to all Councillors.
  
- c) Email sent from Rhydian Roberts, National Park this afternoon to discuss trees near Nant y Felin entrance that need attention:
  - 5 trees have ash dieback.
  - 1 Sycamore tree is growing on a wall.
  - 1 Llwyfan tree needs attention.Above discussed. NO OBJECTIONS to cutting the trees except all councillors need clarification as to why only 50% and not 100% of the Llwyfan tree will be cut. RR to send email asap in response.
  
- d) Robert W Jones, footpath officer Gwynedd, has confirmed work will soon start to repair Penra Du to Shore footpath. Clearing and hedge cutting already done, RWJ also requesting information about the condition of the bridge that leads up to Nant Heilyn footpath at Cremlyn. Councillor Eryl Williams informed us that part of the footpath is in Llanllechid. Clerk to speak to RWJ.
