Annual Report.

The Council comprises 5 Councillors and 1 clerk. The annual precept awarded by Gwynedd Council is £4,000. The Council meet on a quarterly basis (plus extra meeting as and when required. Dates of meetings are on website.

Financial Update.

The Council has maintained a healthy financial position throughout the year and the clerk has ensured regular engagements with the relevant accountant and auditors. The clerk has placed a hard copy of the Financial Report and Notice of Dates in the Council Noticeboard and a copy on the website as required by the Auditors.

Community Engagement.

The clerk has engaged with residents on behalf of the Council by sharing information of local relevance and interest via email and noticeboard eg. roadworks. road closures. Agenda, Minutes and Financial Reports have been produced and published on Aber CC website in line with requirements.

Achievements.

Parking remains an acute problem in the village, the Community Council continues to work closely with relevant agencies and elected representatives in an attempt to resolve the matter.

-The long awaited Double Yellow Lines agreed by Gwynedd Council should soon be in place.

-Safer pedestrian /cycle path between Aber and Madryn bridge completed.

-Quiet tarmac work completed between Aber and Madryn bridge.

-Slip Road lengthened by Penta Aber Farm, unfortunately it was not possible for engineers to improve the slip road in /out of the village.

The Council works closely with NRW, PCE, and Cyngor Gwynedd to address maintenance issues relating to footpaths, dog fouling, hedge cutting, fly tipping, and refuse collection.

Work will hopefully commence this Summer on the footpath at the bottom of the Ffridd.

The Council liaise with Fferm Henfaes re. grass, bracken cutting on the Ffridd footpaths.

The Council continues to provide the annual contribution towards maintenance of village churchyard.

The Council will continue to annually support local charities and good causes. £300 was

donated to Eisteddfod Genedlaethol Llyn a Eifionydd.

Meeting in Hen Felin with Ardal Ni 2035 team was successful, they will return for further discussions sometime this year.

(The Ardal Ni Tidying team have visited twice to remove the graffiti on underpass.)

Training plan for Councillors in place on the website in line with requirements.

Trees donated to village to celebrate 70 years of Parc Cenedlaethol Eryri have been planted in Forestry Car Park.

Council are involved in the Biodiversity and Resilience of Ecosystem survey and the public access Defibrillator Census in line with requirements.
